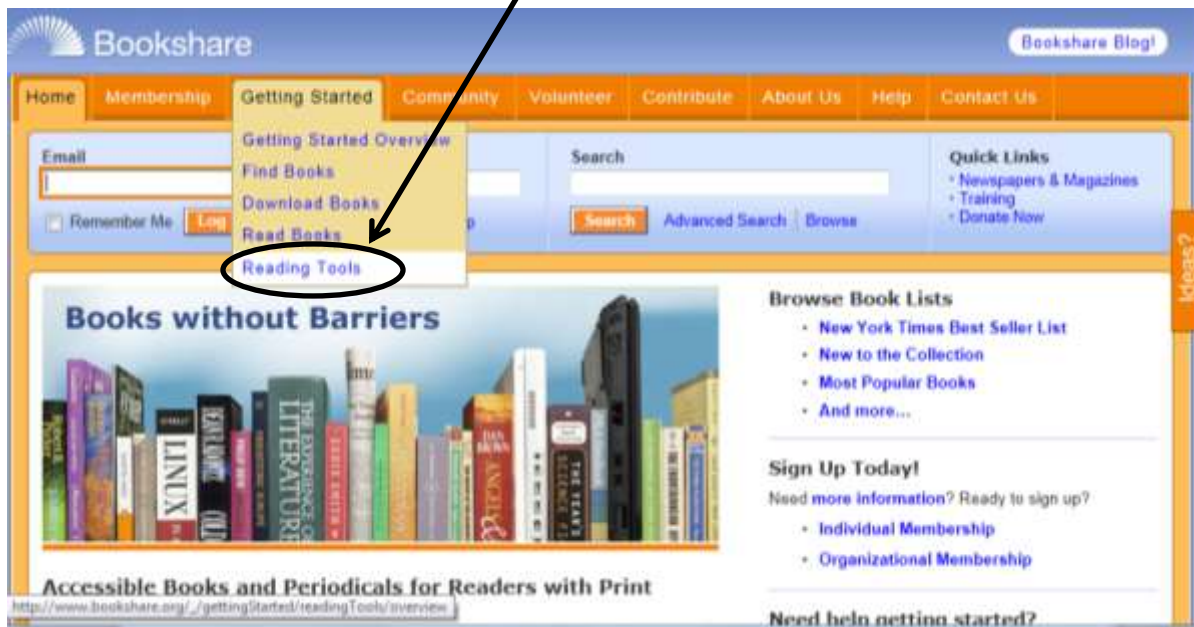


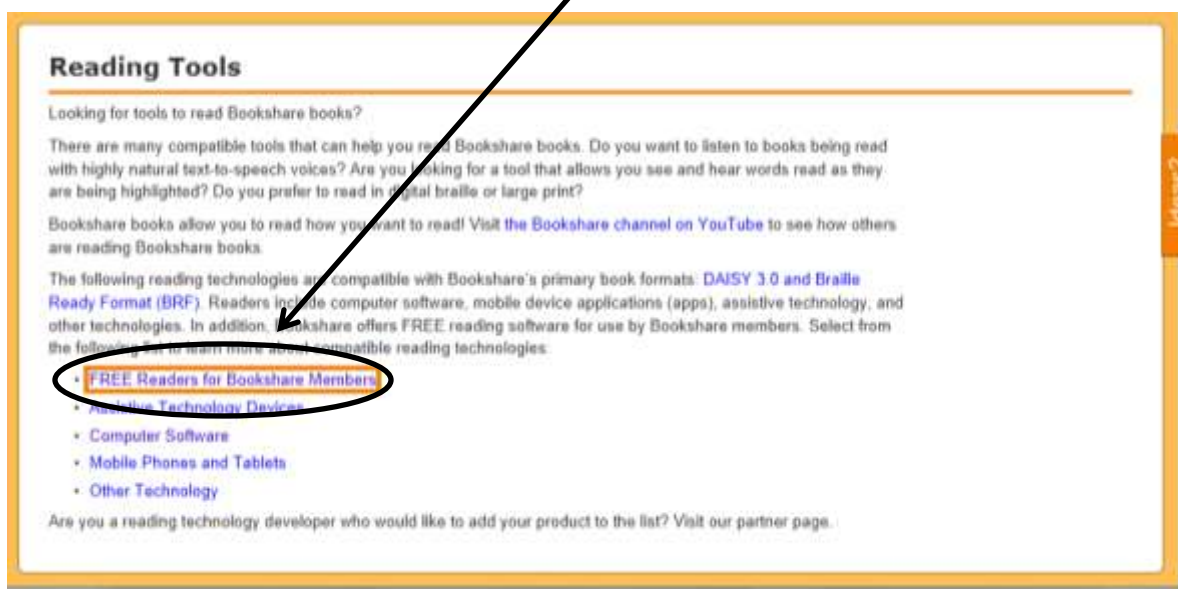
## Read:OutLoud Bookshare Edition

### Download Instructions

1. Go to Bookshare.org and log in with your user name and password.
2. Select the Getting Started tab, Reading Tools.



3. From the Reading Tools page, select Free Readers for Bookshare Members.



4. Select Download Read:OutLoud (for PC or Mac). Note that this page also has a Bookshare Edition 30-Minute Tutorial and a User Manual that can also be downloaded.

- **Victor Reader Soft Bookshare Edition by HumanWare (PC only)**  
Victor Reader Soft version 2.6 is designed for people who are blind or have low vision. This is a self-voicing, full-featured DAISY reader that reads only Bookshare books. Please note that future versions of this software will no longer be developed; however, you can continue to use it and get support from Bookshare.

5. Depending on your platform (PC or MAC), your browser (e.g. Firefox, Safari, Internet Explorer, etc.) and your operating system, when you click on the download link you may get a dialog box asking if you want to Save or Run. You may choose either, but if you choose to Save the file, make a note of where you put it.
  - a. If you choose to Run the file, it should install the Read:OutLoud software for you.
  - b. If you choose to Save the file, you will have to open the installation file and follow the directions for installing the software.
