BIGtrack Giant Trackball

The BIGtrack has a 3 inch trackball. The large ball requires less fine motor control. It has a left and a right mouse click button located behind the trackball to avoid unwanted mouse clicks. It is also equipped to work with switches if your student or client is unable to access the mouse click buttons. USB compatible

SAM Joystick (Switch Adapted Mouse Joystick)

The SAM Joystick uses a joystick to control the mouse. The speed of the mouse movements is controlled and software is available to program other functions of the joystick. The joystick has buttons used to click, double-click and drag. These buttons are also switched adapted for alternate access options. USB compatible

Rock Adapted Joystick

The Rock Adapted Joystick uses a joystick that requires minimal hand movement for cursor control. It includes three different joystick



handles: a straight stem, a T-bar and a large soft ball. The right and left mouse click buttons can be programmed for a left or right hand user. Both mouse click buttons are also switch adapted. The Rock Adapted Joystick also has the ability to drag-lock, double-click, and scroll. PS2 and USB compatible
