- The Grid 2 software offers preprogrammed page sets using SymbolStix or text to build novel sentences
- You can also access your Windows desktop and other programs, with the built in Computer Control features.
- Send and receive email and sms messages, browse the web, listen to music, and more
- The Grid 2 is accessible via a variety of input methods including switches, headpointers, and touchscreen.

Communicator 4 software can be used by people who need AAC and want to use the same program to email, text message and access environmental controls. Built-in support for text messaging and email, enables users with cognitive disability to take advantage of modern technology through a simplified user interface. This program also offers full control of the computer through onscreen keyboards and mouse displays for those users who are unable to control a computer through a standard keyboard and mouse. - full support for synthesized and/or digitized speech

- Ability to create custom user dictionaries for powerful word prediction
