

SHORT CUT SHEET

EASYTALK



The EasyTalk is a compact, lightweight, easy-to-use communication device with 8 levels and up to 32 minutes of digitized recording in standard play and 56 minutes in long play. Turn on – knob is located on right side of device, it will click when turned on.

TO RECORD

1. The EasyTalk must be in Record mode. Slide setup switch 1 to the left where it says Record/Play: Mode: Record /Play
2. Change the level to the one that you wish to record messages on.
3. Press the **Record** button – the LED above will flash indicating that the EasyTalk is ready to record.
4. Press a key upon which to record the message and hold it.
5. The message key will light up and after a moment, you will hear a single beep.
6. Continue to hold the message button and speak into the microphone at a distance of 4 -5 inches.
7. Release the message key when the message is complete. You will hear 2 beeps, indicating that the recording is complete.
8. To listen to the message you just recorded, press the same message key again.

PLAYING BACK MESSAGES

1. Messages can be played back in both **Record** and **Play** mode.
2. It is recommended that when you are finished recording you put the EasyTalk back in Play mode to prevent accidental erasure of messages you have recorded. To do this, slide the setup switch 1 to the right.

CHARGING

To recharge the EasyTalk, plug the charger into a wall outlet and the other end into the **Charger Port** on the left side. The LED next to the Charger Port will light up, indicating that it is charging. For a full charge leave the EasyTalk plugged in for at least 8 hours uninterrupted.
