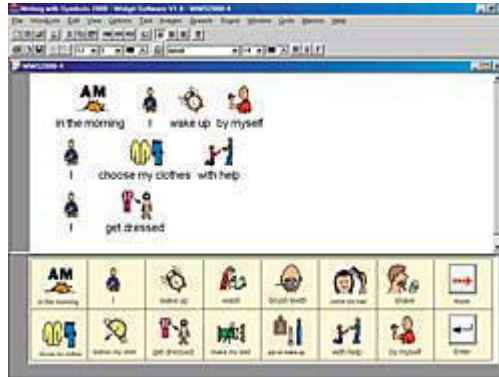


SHORTCUT SHEET

WRITING WITH SYMBOLS 2000



Writing with Symbols 2000 is the versatile program that helps teachers give students the early writing experiences that are essential to literacy development. Students learn to communicate, read and write with the same symbol set. Create picture-word stories for student to read, or create word and symbol displays students can use to write. Speech feedback emphasizes the connection between words and pictures, and a talking word processor connects spoken words with written words. Includes 3800 Picture Communication Symbols and 4000 Rebus symbols. New version features scanning capabilities, new voices and improved environment setups.

TO USE

1. From the Start menu, select the **My Computer** Icon and click on the CD icon in the D-Drive.
2. Click the **Setup** Icon. A registration page will come up. Enter your name, organization, and the registration number from the CD case.
3. Agree to installation procedures.
4. If you have Windows 2000 or XP, install text reader. Choose the language of the dictionary for spell check.
5. Click **Install**.
6. When the Graphics Resources window appears, choose to run the graphics off the CD, save to the Hard Drive, or upgrade existing Graphics Resources.
7. Read Important Information contents and click **OK**.
8. Open the application from the Desktop or from the Start Menu under Programs.
9. Be sure to carefully read all of the tips that pop up in order to understand the basics of the toolbar and application.
