Lectures in the time of Covid

- Live Lectures (Synchronous)
 - Otter.ai app (Android /iOS)
 - Free for 600 minutes/month and 3 audio / video uploads
 - Google Live Transcribe (Android)
 - Free
 - Zoom Integrations
 - Otter.ai
 - Enterprise subscription through district
 - Offers realtime, onscreen transcription for Zoom meetings
 - Grain
 - Enterprise subscription through district
 - Beta not yet released (as of 5/4/2020)
 - Realtime transcription for zoom
 - Allows users to take notes and synchronize them with the video. Allows people to highlight notes and get the associated video clip.
 - Are these lectures being recorded and posted afterwards?
 - Transcribed using Otter.ai
 - Otter.ai offers three free uploads of audio or video for free accounts. A recorded lecture can be uploaded to the service for transcription
 - Transcribe using YouTube
 - YouTube automatically captions videos. A student could upload a lecture and click the three dots (below video on right side) to get the transcription.

- A free Google extension that lets a student take notes on a Youtube video. Very cool tool.
- Asynchronous Learning
 - PowerPoints / Google Slides
 - Speaker notes / Read & Write highlighting tools
 - Annotate with Kami (an online PDF editor)

Note Taking Apps

- Notability (\$8.99 iOS)
 - Customizable Subjects and Dividers
 - Apple Pencil Support
 - Search including Handwriting
 - Audio recording synced with notes
 - Add photos, web pages, documents such as PPT's, DOC's, PDF's
 - Lists and checkboxes
 - Side by side view
 - o Built-in document scanner
 - Cloud backup
- Apple Notes (Free iOS
 - Document scanner with search
 - Image search
 - Checklists (quick and easy)
 - File attachments
 - Apple Pencil
- Audio Note (\$12.99 iOS)
 - Synced notes and audio recordings
 - Highlighted notes during playback
 - Audio seek by tapping notes
 - Audio amplifier for low volume recordings
 - o Import PDF's

Other Tools

Livescribe



- Echo (no i-Device required) (\$179, used for about \$50, notebooks- \$25 for a 4-pack)
 - Notes synced with audio recording
 - Pen and Notebook based (Special dot paper, mic on pen)
 - On-pen storage with backup to Desktop App (using USB)
 - Pencasts
 - Handwriting search in desktop app
- Livescribe 3 (no price listed)
 - i-Device, pen and notebook required
 - Bluetooth connection
 - Uses mic on the i-Device
 - Livescribe PDF's
 - All storage is on the i-device
- Aegir (\$120)
 - Can save notes on pen (no audio
 - Uses i-Device to record audio
 - Livescribe PDF's
 - Slim design
- Sonocent (MacOS, WIndows) (\$149/yr or \$349 lifetime)
 - Capture audio, text and slides in a single note-taking workspace.
 - Organize notes
 - Use your i-Device to capture recordings (link app)
 - Web only client coming soon?
